RISK ASSESSMENTS AND EMERGENCY PLANS

Even before your work takes place, you should be thinking about your risk assessments, method statements and emergency plans. With a team of serving and former emergency service specialists with years of pre-hospital medicine, rescue and fire services experience, along with our directors twenty years as a search and rescue team volunteer and officer in charge we can and do bring this knowledge and experience to our customers to help with their emergency rescue planning.

Our emergency planning department can help provide a tailored solution for emergency planning, working along guidelines such as those set out by the HSE. These plans can be very simple in the case of small works to documents of over fifty pages for larger projects.

GAS TESTING

We use suitably Authorized and qualified Gas Testers from a reputable local company, who can test the atmosphere within a confined or other restricted space and issue a Gas Free Certificate (This is not a permit to work) prior to any works taking place.

We recommend (as per HSE) that all employers operate a permit to work system for any confined space entry's or hot/cold work within their business activities. Creating a complete risk assessment and method statement prior to any work task being started will determine the need for a Gas Test of the area.

In addition, Gas Tests are required for areas where a flammable atmosphere (one of the perceived risks for confined space working) may be present although it is not actually a small or restricted space.

An example of this would be onboard ships that are in dry dock for works.

CONFINED SPACE STANDBY SAFETY TEAM

Our Specialist Rescue Unit staff are also able to provide specialist safety and confined space rescue support to industrial sites and construction projects.

They normally work from a van based response unit carrying all their SCBA Sets, Gas monitoring equipment, confined space rescue access equipment, medical equipment including defibrillator, resuscitators and trauma kits and any additional specialist rescue equipment and PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) that they may need for the duty.
