WHY MOUNTAIN SAFETY?

When working in Mountainous and Remote Locations, on construction sites or other similar projects requiring building or dismantling of infrastructure and similar, various parts of the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM) 2015 as amended now apply. This includes the laying of, or removal of temporary cables and other types of work, previously exempt including communications.

There are also various other additional Regulations within the **Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM) 2015** that are applicable in the remote and mountain environment depending on the type of project, and those that to do with emergency response.

RISK ASSESSMENTS AND EMERGENCY PLANS

Even before your project takes place, you should be thinking about your risk assessments, method statements and emergency plans. With a team of serving and former emergency service specialists with years of pre-hospital medicine, technical rescue and fire services experience, along with our directors twenty years as a search and rescue team volunteer and officer in charge we <u>can and do</u> bring this knowledge and experience to our customers to help with their emergency rescue planning.

Our emergency planning department can help provide a tailored solution for emergency planning, working along guidelines such as those set out by the HSE. These plans can be very simple in the case of small works to documents of over fifty pages for larger projects.

SITE SURVEYS

We advise that before the project commences, one of our safety supervisors who specialise in mountain rescue visit the site to assess for themselves the hazards and risks involved, both in the work being undertaken, and the site itself.

This visit will be followed with a report with our impartial recommendations for both the project and the suggested safety provision (if necessary).

MOUNTAIN STANDBY SAFETY TEAM

Our Workforce Safety Unit staff are also able to provide specialist safety and rescue support to sites and projects.

They normally work from a 4x4 response unit carrying all their PFPE, rope rescue and access equipment, water rescue equipment, medical equipment including defibrillator, resuscitators and trauma kits and any additional specialist rescue equipment and PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) that they may need for the duty.
