Do I Need Water Safety?

It is a requirement under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 that Employers required to ensure, as reasonably practicable the HSW of employees and provide a safe working environment and necessary PPE. This includes working on or near water.

In addition, The Construction (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1996, Regulation 35 requires employers engaged in construction work to take all reasonably practical measures to prevent persons falling into water and drowning.

So, YES you do need to think about water safety for your project to ensure your workforce stays safe.


