Course Aims – To give candidates the knowledge, skills and understanding necessary for them to have the required awareness of the potential risks and safety issues found in remote, upland and mountainous areas when working.

- Basic Emergency Aid & Emergency Procedures.

The course will enable delegates to:

- Determine a full and proper risk assessment and method statement for work in remote and mountain areas.
- Understand the specific risks found in the working environment.
- Choose the correct and suitable PPE for workers in the environment.
- Determine location using both traditional and technological methods for emergencies.
- Be able to provide immediate emergency aid and know the correct emergency procedures for the environment being worked in.

SO WHAT DOES THIS MEAN...

This is a subject specific course for film/TV and other remote workers who have duties in remote, upland and mountain environments across the United Kingdom.

It does not make you a mountain rescuer but will give the worker the required basic knowledge they need to be able to undertake their duties safely.
